EASING OF COVID-19 PROCEDURES

According to Government regulations contact tracing is not necessary anymore, so we will no longer take bookings for Mass or record contact details of those who haven't booked. Ministers of hospitality will check temperatures but not record them. The first hundred people to arrive will be able to sit inside. Thereafter, the ministers will check whether seats are still available and admit more people if possible. Many seats will be available for those who wish to sit outside.

SEATING AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

Those who live under the same roof and who wish to sit *close together* may choose to sit in one of the five benches in the *back half* of the church, where there are *no marked seats*. Alternating benches are ribboned off. Please maintain 1.5 metres between groups. Those who wish to sit *further apart* should sit in the *front half* of the church, where places are marked with arrows: *one person per arrow*.

PLEASE KEEP MASKS ON

Masks, covering the nose and mouth, must be worn at all times to avoid the risk of “aerosol transmission” of the virus. Please move your mask from your mouth *before* extending your hands to receive Holy Communion.
